"Musical Freestyle Remote Learning Program" - This three-hour program was developed to be presented remotely as a distance learning opportunity. There are four 45-minute sessions that GMOs can schedule in a variety of ways. It is designed to focus on the lower-level freestyles and is approved for L Graduate Continuing Education. Presenters of this program must be USEF licensed 'S' Dressage Judges with the USEF Freestyle designation. This program cannot be recorded to be played at a later date.

□ "Taste of the USDF L Education Program" – Remote-This three-hour program was developed to be presented remotely as a distance learning opportunity. There are three one-hour sessions that GMOs can schedule in a variety of ways. It is designed to give an overview of the L Education Program Part 1. The Taste of the L Program is approved for L Graduate Continuing Education (three hours if all three sessions are completed. Passing an online quiz is required).
