2023 USDF Dressage Sport Horse Championship Class Sheet

Purpose: To determine a Champion & Reserve Champion within a judging category. A Third Place Reserve Champion is also required for Foal, Filly, Colt, Four-Year Old Prospect, Mare and Stallion Championship classes.

Participation: The first, second and sometimes third place winners in each of the previously judged qualifying classes (within a category) may be invited to enter that Championship class.

Requirements: More than one judge may officiate. Entries will be re-evaluated with or without awarding scores. All horses will be re-evaluated in the same manner, and all horses must be shown at the walk and trot (and canter, in applicable classes). All entries must be present in the ring for judging, in order to be eligible. Horses may be asked to walk or trot individually or as a group, or entries may be asked to move individually on the triangle. If the number of entries is sufficient, a champion, reserve champion and third place reserve must be named in qualifying classes for the USDF Breeders Championships series.

The Following Championship Classes may be offered at the discretion of management:

Details must be included in the prize list.

- **Foal Championship:** For Filly and Colt classes of the current calendar year (Fillies and Colts will be shown together in this class).
- Filly Championship: For Filly classes from yearling up to and including age 3.
- **Colt/Gelding Championship:** For Colt/Gelding classes from yearling to and including age 3.
- Four-Year Old Prospect Championship: For four-year old gelding, mare, and stallion prospect classes.
- Mare Championship: For Brood, Maiden and Yeld mare classes.
- Stallion Championship: For Stallion classes.
- Young Horse Championship: Open to Champion & Reserve Champion in Foal (at the discretion of show management), Filly & Colt Championship classes
- Mature Horse Championship: Open to Champion & Reserve Champion in Mare & Stallion Championship classes.
- **Grand Championship:** Open to winners of all Championship (in-Hand) classes, or to Champion & Reserve Champion in Young Horse & Mature Horse Championship classes.
- **Under Saddle Championship:** For all Under Saddle classes.
- Materiale Championship: For Materiale classes.

NOTE: This scoresheet is NOT to be used in USDF Breeders Championship Series Final classes. In USDF Breeders Championship Series Final classes, refer to USDFBC guidelines. Horses in USDF Breeders Championship Series Final in-hand classes must be shown individually on the triangle at the walk and trot, and standing for conformation. Individual scoresheets are required for USDF Breeders Championship Series Final classes.

Materiale Championships will be held at each USDFBCS series final competition. Each USDFBCS series final will hold a Three-Year-Old, Four-Year Old, and Five-Year Old Materiale Championship classes. Horses will be evaluated using the current "USDF Materiale Class" scoresheet.
